Why eLearning Days?



- To prepare students for independent learning for college and workforce
- Allows for professional development opportunities for staff, without loss of instructional time or finding subs
- All staff will report to work and get paid
- Prepare everyone for inclement weather school days by 2018 - 19 school year



What are we doing?



Step 1

Submit eLearning application to the DOE

Step 2

eLearning Flex Pilot (expanded)
4 scheduled days within the school year
(1 elearning day / 9 weeks)

Step 3

eLearning Days can replace days lost to inclement weather (can also be continued as scheduled days for PD)

Who participates?



Grades 5-12

- These students stay at home
- They can ride normal bus routes/times to study hall/lunch if desired
- Ivy Tech/Career center students will still attend their classes at career center
- Extra-curricular activities are by coach discretion

Practice: Students report to school, teachers & students practice independent learning.

Optional: Students may stay home for independent learning or they may report to school. (This will be determined based on practice success and grade level administrative decision).

Participate: Students will stay home for independent learning. (Exceptions may be considered by administration).



eLearning Days When Students Are At School (“Practice” & “Optional”)

- Grades K-6 will run per the normal everyday schedule. (Class, Specials, Recess, Lunch, etc... will all run at the normal time)
- Teachers & students in grades K-6 will simulate eLearning activities and lessons during regularly scheduled classroom time.

Instructional Assistants will cover their normal day-to-day assignments if students are present, as well provide supplemental assistance to grade levels present in the building. In addition, Instructional Assistants may attend Professional Development, attend meetings, or assist with coverage with any available time.

Title staff will cover their normal day-to-day assignments if students are present, as well as provide remedial assistance (RTI) to students in grade levels present in the building. In addition, Title Staff may attend Professional Development, attend meetings, or assist with coverage with any available time.



Expectations



- Students complete school work on chromebooks/ipads
- Can download material at school to work without internet at home
- Teachers will have office hours for help by phone, email, Google Hangouts (grades 9-12 only)
- School work is due Thursday or Friday by teacher discretion
- Attendance is counted by school work submitted by due date
