MINUTES OF THE MARCH 12, 2020
FACILITIES & GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING

The Facilities and Grounds Committee of the Board of School Trustees met for discussion of current issues and future plans for the Corporation on Monday, March 12, 2020, beginning at 5:35 P.M. at the Switzerland County Administration Building, located at 1040 W. Main Street, Vevay, Indiana.

DISCUSSION:

Discussion Items:

Town of Vevay Easements

The Town of Vevay Engineer, Mike Meyer, presented revised drawings and discussed two possible locations for sewer main replacement:

- 1) The most direct route is behind the track and softball field as long as they are able to place this 10ft separation from the wastewater and the water main. They would directionally bore anything near the track. Mr. Hite requests a written agreement that the Town will repair any damage to the track.
- 2) In the front of the property, with force main directional drillings at each one of our entrances at a time that will not disrupt school such as during the summer

Mr. Bosaw asked for clarification of the timeline. Mr. Meyer responded that the construction would not take place until 2022. As next steps, the town will be drilling near the track in several different areas to have 100% identification of the water main. The town will provide the revised easements at the April Board meeting to be voted on at that time. The deadline for the Town to apply for the grant is May 22, 2020.

Long Range Planning

Mr. Hite stated that he visited Salem Community School Corporation to tour their 200 mph rated classroom/multi-purpose building. Mr. Hite reported that the FEMA grant covers the cost to make it a 200 mpr rated building and the school corporation pays for everything up to that point. Next step is to prioritize the list of long range renovation and construction need(s).

Mr. Hite has invited Endowment Committee Members and Endowment representatives from County Commissioners and County Council to the Facilities and Grounds Committee meeting scheduled for April 20, 2020.
